WHAT IS A DIAPER BANK?

A diaper bank is a nonprofit group that collects, stores and distributes diapers to homeless shelters, food pantries, family service agencies and faith-based organizations.

THE DIAPER GAP

1 in 3 families experience diaper need and rely on diaper banks to fill that gap.

Households experiencing diaper need are an average of **50** diapers short a month.

\$70-\$90 diapers cost per month per baby.

Number of Federal programs that cover diapers = **0**
